*Over the past several years, community members in the Northwest School District have been unable to come to an agreement on an acceptable method to address the needs of the students in our District. Despite the recent passing of a technology bond, we understand that many needs still exist. This group was formed in an effort to address some of these immediate needs.*

*And while we may not have the resources necessary to build a building, does that mean we should do nothing at all? WE CAN show the youth in our community that their education is our top priority. WE CAN make a difference. WE CAN DO SOMETHING!*

**OUR GOAL** is to find at least 100 people who are willing to give \$100 per quarter to benefit the education of the children in our community.

**OUR PURPOSE** is to fund at least one school project each quarter. Each project must be able to be completed for a total cost of \$10,000 or less. These projects can be any upgrade or improvement that is needed within the District. They may be educational enhancements, technology upgrades, facility improvements, etc.

Each of the five school buildings will present projects for the voters' consideration. Each member gets one vote per share at \$100 per quarter or \$400 contributed per year. The project that gets the most votes each quarter will receive funding.

Our long range goal is to fund multiple projects each quarter as our membership grows.

Mounties on a Mission meetings will be held quarterly in February, May, August, and November of each year. An email reminder will be sent in advance of each meeting as well as absentee voting instructions.
